About the Show:-

Fissure is an extended walking and performance event in the beautiful setting of the Yorkshire Dales from 20 to 22 May. Starting out on the evening of Friday 20th, the audience will explore the area over three days - covering a distance of 12 miles on Saturday 21st, and resuming the walk early on Sunday 22nd morning. The event ends late morning on Sunday at a spectacular location.

There are three categories of ticket prices. All tickets include:

- all transportation around the site from the start/end points (Settle or Kirby Stephen stations)
- dinner on Friday and Saturday evenings
- packed lunch on Saturday
- brunch post event on Sunday
- refreshments and snacks throughout.

There are three tiers of ticket types, two are inclusive of accommodation. NB Accommodation is limited in the area, if you plan to book your own.

The **ticket prices per person** for the entire event (inclusive of VAT) vary according to the kind of accommodation required:-

£250 for 2 nights B&B accommodation
£220 for 2 nights bunkhouse accommodation (bedlinen supplied)
£170 if accommodation is not required.

If you do not require accommodation or wish to book your own, you will need to make your own way to and from an allocated start/end point on Saturday and Sunday (the latter will be a very early start).

Joining.

You will need to make your own way to Settle or Kirby Stephen railway stations on the Settle Carlisle railway; by 6pm on Friday 20th May. (See <http://www.settle-carlisle.co.uk/timetables/index> for timetable).

We will advise you which station (Settle or Kirby Stephen) depending on where you are coming from, and according to availability.

If you intend to drive, there is parking at each railway station. Artevents will organise for you to collect your car from the station at the end of the day.

All participants are requested to be on time for pick-ups as Artevents will not keep the group waiting for latecomers.

Personal baggage will be transported as needed throughout the weekend.

The walk is open only to persons above 14 years of age. Anyone between 14-18 years must be accompanied by a parent / legal guardian.

Sorry, pets are not allowed.

Fissure will begin at 6pm on Friday 20 May and end at 12 noon on Sunday 22 May. The second day, Saturday 21 May, involves a 12 mile walk across hilly terrain. There will be an extremely early start – around dawn – on Sunday. The entire walk has been graded by our risk assessors as strenuous* and is conducted according to recommended Health and Safety requirements.

* *Strenuous level of walking:* The walk is over 12 miles and there may be difficult terrain where the ground is uneven, rocky or steep. Walkers should be equipped with sturdy, waterproof boots and extra warm layers of clothing, including a waterproof / windproof outer layer, hat and gloves.

Audience members are required to have the necessary fitness level to go on the walk. You are solely responsible for judging your level of fitness. However Artevents reserves the right to estimate a participant's fitness levels and to turn away participants at any stage of the walk.

Fissure is an all-weather performance and will continue even in the event of heavy rain or other weather conditions that are severe but not dangerous.

Fissure by its nature cannot be rescheduled or restaged. Artevents reserves the right to cancel the performance or

alter the route for *Fissure*, without notice, in case of inclement weather or other circumstances beyond the organisers' control.

Fissure is a guided walk, along public footpaths as well as through private land. Audience members are required to follow the route set by the trained guides and remain with the walking group at all times.
